Background:





Punjab Energy Development Agency, Government of Punjab in association with Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Ministry of Power, Govt. of India organized a one-day Conference & Expo on 'Investment Bazaar for Energy Efficiency' on 26th November 2021 at Hotel Hyatt, Chandigarh.

The objective of the event was to create the awareness among industry stakeholders on different financing schemes, EE product/services, ESCO mode of implementation of EE projects. Also, provide the common platform to OEMs, ESCOs, Financial Institutions, and Industries to interact and discuss the investment as well as financial potential. More than 100 participants from Industries, OEMs, ESCOs, and Financial Institutions were part of this event.

Inaugural Event:

The conference and exhibition was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister, Department of New & Renewable Energy Sources, Govt. of Punjab, Dr. Raj Kumar Verka ji, Chairman PEDA, Sh. H.S. Hanspal ji, Chief Executive Officer, PEDA, Sh. Navjot P.S. Randhawa ji, Director, PEDA, Sh. M.P. Singh ji, Senior Manager, PEDA, Sh. Paramjit Singh ji in the august gathering of more than 100 participants from various DCs, Industries, MSMEs, OEMs, various Industry associations etc.









Financing in the field of Energy Efficiency projects has been found as a major tool to accelerate EE projects undertaken by industries. Recognizing and acknowledging this fact, this one-day conference organized to to address the following:-

1. To enhance investments in the projects of energy efficiency

2. To overcome barriers and myths related to funding of EE projects

3. To bridge the communication and knowledge gap between project implementers and funding agencies.

4. To highlight the practical problems and to address them with collective deliberations of all stakeholders

5. To stimulate the market dynamics in the field of Energy Efficiency and make it more market oriented.

Objective of Investment Bazaar:

Energy Efficiency Financing Platform (EEFP) is one of the initiatives under National Mission for Enhanced Energy Efficiency (NMEEE) for promoting financing of Energy Efficiency Projects. In order to meet objective of Energy Efficiency Financing Platform (EEFP) this conference & expo have been organized at Chandigarh, wherein most of existing Designated Consumers (DCs)



under PAT scheme as well as other industries and MSMEs along with trainees of Conference for FIs on EE Financing was invited. The duration of the conference & expo was one day. The bankers / NBFCs have been invited to put their stalls at the venue for showcasing their financing products available for EE projects. There were more than 100 participants in this one day conference.

As per BEE's UNNATEE study, there is potential of Rs. 1 lakh crore annual investments in energy efficiency. The major aim of this investment bazaar is to bring all the stakeholders of Energy Efficiency at one place to increase the business in energy efficiency measures & technologies, and accelerate energy efficiency financing.

Speaker Highlights:



In this conference, Sh. Raj Kumar Verka, Hon'ble Minister for New & Renewable Energy Sources, Govt. of Punjab has emphasized upon importance of energy efficiency & implementation of new and innovative energy efficient technologies in Industries & MSME in the State. He also focused over the investment potential in Industries & MSMEs which can enhance the infrastructure at the state level. He stressed upon the dynamics of industry, transport, buildings and agriculture sectors are bringing new opportunities. In



addition, he mentioned that energy is slowly transitioning to be demand driven than supply driven. He also deliberated upon importance to bridge the communication and knowledge gap between project implementers and funding agencies for the implementation of energy efficient activities in Industries & MSMEs.



Sh. H.S. Hanspal, Chairman, PEDA briefed about the conference and importance & involvement of industries & MSMEs for implementation of energy efficiency projects in the State which will boost economy and suggested that banks / financial institutions shall provide extending support for such projects in the State. He deliberated upon importance to stimulate the market dynamics in the field of Energy Efficiency and make it more market oriented.

Sh. Navjot Pal Singh Randhawa, IAS, Chief Executive Officer, PEDA mentioned that Punjab is now being considered to play a leading role in the energy transition in India by deployment of clean and low-carbon solutions and renewable energy in part of the NAPCC for transition to renewable Energy Systems and also to fulfil renewable purchase obligations. The shifting patterns would push the state to redefine the way energy sector operates on a day-to-day basis through utilizing higher cleaner and low-carbon power generation,



providing low-carbon heating and cooling for domestic and commercial demand sectors, clean cooking fuels, increasing energy access to rural areas, modernizing agriculture practices amongst others. He also suggested that the demonstration of successful implementation of Energy Efficiency projects to create inspiration among other Stakeholders for implementation of such EE projects in the Industries & MSMEs.



Ms. Vineeta Kanwal, Director, Bureau of Energy Efficiency, Ministry of Power, Govt. of India highlighted that in India there is huge investment potential of approx. Rs. 1 lakh crore annually in energy efficiency. There are approx. 14 financial institutions that are providing energy efficiency loan and seeking Partial Risk Sharing Facility guarantee too. BEE has recently launched a new financing programme for grading of energy efficiency projects where cost of grading for 100 graded and financed projects shall be borne by BEE. Ministry of Power has appointed Power Finance Corporation (PFC) as nodal agency for accelerating energy efficiency financing in India. BEE and PFC are in process of rolling out new financing mechanisms such as interest subvention and credit guarantee schemes, subject to approval of Ministry of Power.







Sh. M.P. Singh, Director, PEDA shared his views and emphasized about the continuous efforts to translate energy sector strategies into actionable low-carbon solutions are driven by the Punjab Energy and Development Agency (PEDA) to increase the utilization of clean and low-carbon energy. With renewable energy share currently standing at only 15% of the total energy needs, the state has proactively committed to increase the share to 30% by 2030 through the Punjab Vision Document 2030 strategy. The vision not only focuses on the energy generation side, but also stresses the need for demand side interventions across various sectors. In addition, efforts are also required to assess potential penetration of newer technologies such as electric vehicles (EV), carbon, capture, storage and utilisation, hydrogen that could invariably impact the energy demand in the transport and industry sectors and also contribute significantly in reducing the GHG emissions.

























During the Technical Sessions-1, the presentations were given by Ms. Vineeta Kanwal from Bureau of Energy Efficiency wherein she highlighted various schemes of BEE and potential of investment in energy efficiency in industries & MSMEs. She mentioned about the recently launched new financing programme for grading of energy efficiency projects where cost of grading for 100 graded and financed projects shall be borne by BEE. Ministry of Power has appointed Power Finance Corporation (PFC) as nodal agency for accelerating energy efficiency financing in India. BEE and PFC are in process of rolling out new financing mechanisms such as interest subvention and credit guarantee schemes, subject to approval of Ministry of Power. Mr. K.P. Philip from IREDA, shared their schemes and fast approval of loan schemes for MSME & Industries in Renewable Energy projects. Mr. Vineet Gupta from M/s Vardhman Yarns Ltd. showed their case study wherein they implemented energy efficient measures being designated consumer in Punjab. Mr. Sunil Bhagat, Deputy Manager, M/s Ambuja Cements Ltd. presented latest technologies implemented and project for energy efficient financing requirements. Mr. Devinder Singh, M/s Indona Innovative Solutions being ESCO shared the success stories of various energy efficiency projects implemented in Industries & MSMEs.

During the Technical Sessions-2, Mr. Joyant Nayak, from SIDBI presented the various financing schemes beneficial for industries & MSME for implementation of energy efficiency projects. Mr. Ashish Anand from M/s Anand & Anand, MSME shared their potential project for energy efficiency financing regarding energy efficiency projects. M/s R.P. Sharma from Pye Tools (MSME), shared the case study and benefits after implementation of energy efficiency project and shared proposal for requirement of financing for implementation of more such energy efficiency projects. Sh. Yogesh Sood from International Copper Association India shared the benefits of maintaining power quality and improvements to save energy in industries and MSMEs. Mr. Ajay Mittal from Pumpco India presented the latest energy efficient pumping systems available in the market to be used for implementation of energy efficiency in industries. Mr. Sunil Anand from Advance Valves shared about latest technologies related to various types of valves which may be used in the industries.

In this one-day conference, Case Studies on Implementation of energy efficiency in industries & MSMEs, Power Factor Quality improvements, Policies & various financing schemes for investment in energy efficiency were




